## Great golfing getaway

NORTHERN New South Wales offers some great golf courses for all levels of golfers. Recently, golfers have been taking advantage of escaping to private beachfront luxury in a new pavilion-style beach house to enjoy the local Byron Bay area, legendary surf beaches and some golf.

Nestled into the beachfront rainforest just south of this eastern most point of Australia and in an untouched little community called Broken Head, is Pavilion2 at Broken Head. Experience the magical views along the beach walks or venture just a little way up the beach to the entrance to the serene beauty of the natural tea tree lakes. For those looking for something a little less strenuous after a game of golf, simply relax with a good book in the gentle breeze on the deck.

Alternatively enjoy the culture and laidback lifestyle of Byron Bay, Bangalow and the surrounding area renowned for local and fresh produce markets, art galleries, festivals and restaurants.

Visitors to Broken Head can fly into Brisbane or Coolangatta airport then drive south to Broken Head. It is approximately 170km from Brisbane (2 hour drive) or 70km (1 hour drive) from Coolangatta. Alternatively, guests can fly into Ballina airport 20km south of Broken Head. For those driving north from Sydney it is approximately 780km.
